INSTRUCTIONS FOR FLORIDA FAMILY LAW RULES OF PROCEDURE FORM 12.911(e) SUBPOENA FOR DEPOSITION (ISSUED BY CLERK) (04/22)

When should this form be used?

This form is used to require the appearance of witnesses at a deposition and also to notify the other <u>party(ies)</u> of those witnesses you have subpoenaed as required by the Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.410. This form should be typed or printed in black ink. The party issuing the subpoena should sign it and then take it to the <u>clerk of the circuit court's</u> office to obtain the deputy clerk's signature.

NOTE: Under Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.407, unless otherwise provided by law or another rule of procedure, children who are witnesses, potential witnesses, or related to a family law case are prohibited from being subpoenaed to appear at any family law proceeding or from attending any family law proceedings without prior order of the court based on good cause shown. See Forms 12.944(a)–(b).

What should I do next?

The form must be <u>served</u> on the witness(es) in accordance with Florida law and notice must also be given to the other parties in accordance with Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.410 and with Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.516.

Where can I look for more information?

Before proceeding, you should read General Information for Self-Represented Litigants found at the beginning of these forms. The words that are in <u>bold underline</u> in these instructions are defined there. For further information, see Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.410.

Nonlawyer: Remember, a person who is NOT an attorney is called a nonlawyer. If a nonlawyer helps you fill out these forms, that person must give you a copy of a **Disclosure from Nonlawyer**, Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure Form 12.900(a), before he or she helps you. A nonlawyer helping you fill out these forms also **must** put his or her name, address, and telephone number on the bottom of the last page of every form he or she helps you complete.
